

Pros	Cons
Clickers answer without owners Unsure that learning will be improved Will learning transfer? Not easy to observe student thinking Important to have stable groups Remember to include clickers	Technology fails Some students don't answer Hard to do drawing Q's without an app Takes time to choose Q's, even if they are already written Cost & technology Guessing can get right answers


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Pros

- Immediate feedback for both faculty & student
- Instructors can judge frequency of misconceptions
- Provides concrete talking points to continue discussion
- Squelch mental loafers
- Students feel their understanding matters
- Students feel accomplished
- Prevents off task smartphone use

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Can convince lecturer, colleagues to try out active learning (Gateway drug...)
Easy to focus on hard or easy concepts w/ question choice
Significantly higher class attendance
Use it in all classes
Helps students identify imp concepts
We remember things that embarrassed us,
We learn from our mistakes,
Students know others are struggling
Helps students know what tests might be like

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Can hear from quiet students
Encourage students to visit office hours,
They are used to it,
Allows failure in safe environment.

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
